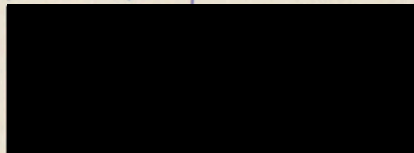

Located on Jupiter Island, Florida, Blowing Rocks Preserve is a 75-acre nature sanctuary owned and managed by The Nature Conservancy.

This barrier island preserve shelters four native plant communities -- oceanfront dune, coastal strand, mangrove wetlands, and tropical hardwood hammock.

The Nature Conservancy is an international, non-profit conservation organization dedicated to the preservation of plants, animals and natural communities that represent the diversity of life on Earth by protecting the lands and waters they need to survive. Since 1951, it has protected more than 10.6 million acres and now manages the largest private system of nature sanctuaries in the world. The Conservancy is supported almost entirely through private, tax-deductible contributions.
