Dear Sir or Madame,

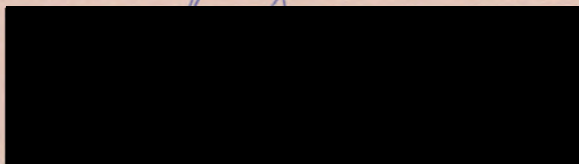
I am writing to praise your airing of The National Press Club - Salute to Ken Burns, creator of the PBS documentary "The Civil War".
