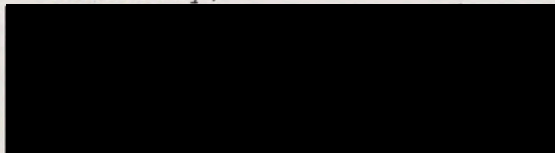
To Whom It May Concern:

I am writing to inform you of something I just found out that makes me absolutely furious and which I find to be totally unbelievable. Multimedia Cablevision here in central Oklahoma will not be carrying C-Span although it is considered basic service until January 1994.

As a result of congressional involvement, the cablevision companies effected changes as of this date. They moved the channels of some of the stations including C-Span. When I could not get C-Span even after programing my set for the new number I called to find out what the problem was. I was informed that due to laying new fiber optic cables in this area we would be without C-Span until January, 1994. I find that interesting especially when not one other station on either the basic package or the premium packages is unavailable.

I plan on complaining to Multimedia tomorrow but I am fully aware that I will get double talk that will infuriate me. I would presume you will find this information most disturbing and can hopefully push some buttons. I am also copying my legislators. They should be concerned also considering the legislative activity that brought about this change. Additionally, we have some terribly important legislative issues coming up -- NAFTA, Health Care. Gee, could there be a connection??
