EXCERPTS FROM C-SPAN INTERVIEW
WITH FMR. HOUSE SPEAKER TIP O'NEILL

Taped on November 9, 1992
Airs November 12, 1992 on Road to the White House
at 9:30 PM (ET) and 12:30 AM (ET)

(On Bush Campaign Strategy in the 1992 Presidential Election)

FMR. SPEAKER TIP O'NEILL: . . . the issue was the economy, and the issue of dodging the draft and the Vietnam war, I was opposed to it, millions of Americans were opposed to it, hundreds of thousands of Americans never wanted to go in the war and were happy and they could see themselves as a Clinton. And they made a terrible mistake on staying on the issue of the Vietnam war and staying on the issue of the draft. They should never have done it. And he (President Bush) never admitted . . . he would never admit that there was a recession out there and that something had to be done about it.



(On the "Cam-Scam" Issue When the Speaker Turned the
Cameras on the House Chamber)

FMR. SPEAKER TIP O'NEILL: . . . Well I was wrong on that, and I will tell you why I was wrong. As a matter of fact in '82 our campaign was fairness. That was the issue of our campaign and we gained 26 seats back. And I've always tried to be fair and whoever the Republican leader was, I never tried to pull anything behind his back without notifying him or anything of that nature. But that afternoon I was sitting in my office and I was watching C-SPAN on the floor and they are on special orders. And I don't remember now whether it was Walker or . . .

C-SPAN: I think it was Bob Walker...

SPEAKER O'NEILL: It was probably Bob Walker. And I picked up the telephone and I called Charlie Rose and I said 'Scan the House, span the House!' Well, he had been saying 'Now, Eddie Boland, stand up and deny this!' And it was something Eddie Boland had said thirty years ago in Congress, you know what I mean, which was completely different, and it infuriated me. Now where I made my mistake, in fairness, I should have called Bob Michel, and said 'Bob, I don't like what I'm going to do, but I'm going to do it.' Or, I should have waited until the following Monday and notified him; no, I didn't give him notification, and I was wrong on that particular thing.

C-SPAN: And by the way, you know one of the things people often miss is that they think we control those cameras, and the House controls them.

(MORE)

SPEAKER O'NEILL: I never allowed you to control those cameras, and don't ever change that.

C-SPAN: Why?

SPEAKER O'NEILL: Well, you know, some guy will be picking his nose or scratching his fanny, and the television at a convention, and that's what it goes on, it goes on the negative. It goes on, always trying to downcast. Let the Congress handle it. They're doing a good job. And, the American people like it, and I don't think that they should show a full-scale debate with thirty members on the floor, or some fellow taking a nap, which could happen on occasion. I just don't think that is in the best interest of our Congress or of our people. And I think everything's going all right and leave it alone.
