I watch C-span every morning and I have given up trying to get through on the phone.

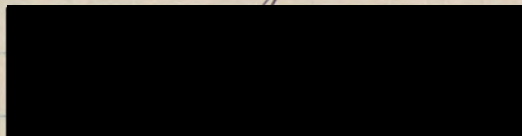
