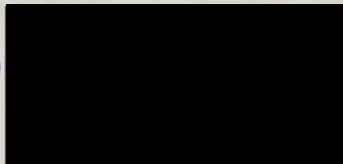


Dear Brian Lamb;

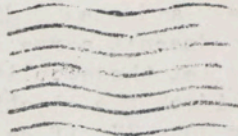
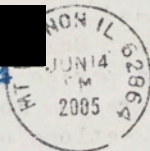
