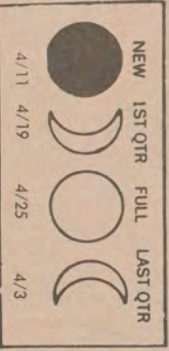

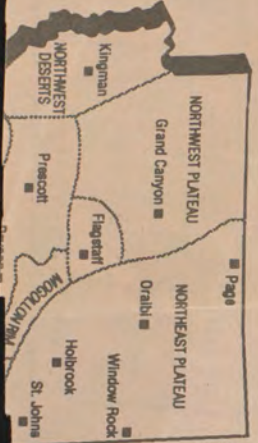

Hurricane force winds were reported in the Rockies from Wyoming into Colorado. Winds gusted to 78 mph at Boulder, Colo., and in Cheyenne, Wyo., winds reached 75 mph. Up to 2 feet of snow fell in Utah and Wyoming.

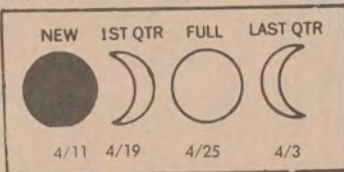

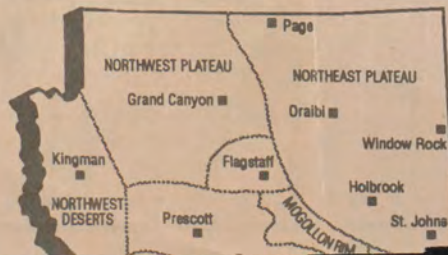

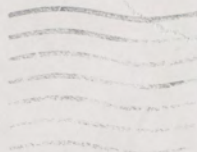
