

THE UNITED STATES CAPITOL
Washington, D.C.

The cornerstone was laid in 1793 by President Washington. Burned by the British in 1812, it was not completed until 1863. The main part of the building is of Massachusetts marble and Virginia sandstone, the dome is a double shell of east iron painted white to harmonize with the rest of the structure.

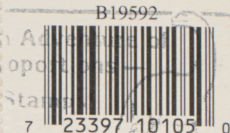
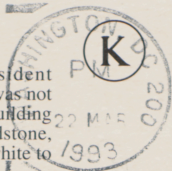
