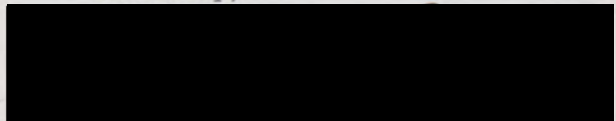
Dear Mr. Lamb:

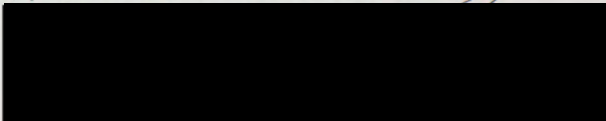
Two positions have been taken, one is Justice and the other is the people's right to know. If the position is taken for the right to know, it will set a precedent to finally remove the function of the Justice Department.

How is constitutional treaty definition affected by this (NAFTA) agreement? If the American people do not get control of their government (President and Congress), the new world order will be installed by 1997!

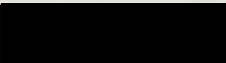

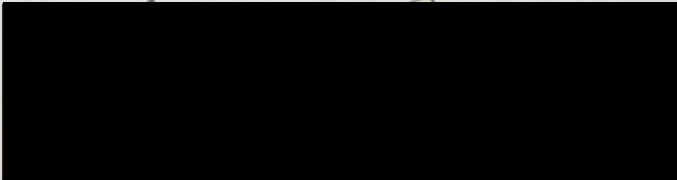
Paying Our Debt
And Penalized For It

There is a question that arises in reference to donations made to "Reduce the Public Debt Fund." That is, should we, the American people, be penalized by the IRS due to the fact that they (IRS) consider this a charitable contribution whereby we (the American people) only receive credit for \$.35 on a dollar?

The reason this question comes about is due to the President's and Congress' claiming that all Americans owe \$17,000 to \$18,000. If this is the case (and I'm sure it is), then we (the American people) should not be penalized for wanting to pay our debt. Therefore, I'm requesting as an American that it be changed to 100% deductible from our total net taxable income, and that deposits (donations) made to this account be also accepted in lieu of taxes owed, if any. This will give the constitutional choice back to the American people, to determine for themselves whether they (the American people) want their money to go towards the public debt or the Federal spending system!

The present system in a nutshell is as follows: If we (the American people) have a savings account (Reduce the Public Debt Fund) and you make a deposit of \$1.00 at your bank (U.S. Treasury),

One's debt should not be considered a charitable donation, but a deposit of 100%! The U.S. Treasury is not a church or a charitable organization!
