I have a suggestion which may improve the utility of your talk programs.

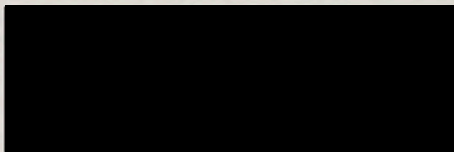
I engage in a dialogue with the presented speakers position. At times when a speaker is talking you display a name and affiliation banner subjacent to the head display. This presents only part of the information I need to communicate directly with the speaker via the mail system. To accomplish this I must have the street address, etc. available.

To be able to utilize the offered information, I need to get mail specific information soon after the idea sparking my interest is presented.

The best method of tying the message to the speaker is to offer the Name;affiliation;address each time the speaker is presented for more than 10 seconds. This will allow us to copy the address down and subsequently mail off our perspective.

In this way C-Span can benefit the quality of the national dialogue.
