As a naturalized American who served in the US Army, but was born in Shanghai, China under the Nationalist regime, I must point out that regardless of one's political affinity for the current regime, I strongly believe that the key to a better Sino-American relationship and for the United States to exert a more positive influence in our democratic systems is:

NOT TO INTERFERE IN THE INTERNAL AFFAIRS OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA. ONE SUCH EXAMPLE IS THE CURRENT FAD, ESPECIALLY AMONG THE HOLLYWOOD CROWD, AND THE HUMAN RIGHT ACTIVISTS TO 'FREE TIBET'.
