C-SPAN CLOSES "CAMPAIGN '86" WITH A CALIFORNIA FOCUS

Cable Network Goes On-Location to Look at State's Races & Issues

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Cable television viewers across the nation will have an opportunity to learn about some of the important issues facing California voters as C-SPAN devotes several hours of pre-election programming to California races and referendums.

In addition, the public affairs cable network will spend a portion of election night, November 4, inside the newsroom of the San Diego Union to watch as its writers and editors gather and report the results of Election '86.

Beginning at 2:00 pm ET/11:00 am PT on Sunday, November 2, C-SPAN will spend several hours on the campaign trail with California politicians and talking with political scientists and reporters about California politics. C-SPAN coverage will focus on California's U.S. Senate race, the governor's race and the election of the state's Chief Justice. Four referendums facing California voters will be examined by the cable network: Propositions 61 and 62 on fiscal matters and taxes; Proposition 63 on English as the official language, and AIDS-related Proposition 64. Additional California programming airs Monday, November 3, beginning at 3:45 pm ET/ 12:45 pm PT.

Finally, on election night, C-SPAN's live cameras will spend fifteen minutes of each hour with live telecasts from the newsroom of the San Diego Union talking with political journalists. This live analysis from the West Coast will be mixed with the network's other special election programming, originating live from C-SPAN's Washington studios and from the Democratic and Republican national headquarters in the nation's capital.
