I appreciate your program and only wish we had televised information concerning Alaska here in Juneau. In order to get information, we must either go down to the sessions at the State House or read another person's interpretation in the newspaper. To have direct communication from the floor of the House of Representatives in Washington has been a delight to me.

I also appreciate all your extra attendance of areas of importance and I must thank you very much for your showing of the program by the U.S. Institute of Peace. I woke up to this wonderful program of scholars from Russia and North America discussing the origin of the cold war. A subject that so few of us understand. I have written to Samuel Lewis, the president of the Institute of Peace, to thank him and the others for their service to us.

Do you have any suggestions about getting a program for our state capitol. We are cut off for the most part in all the other towns and cities due to no roadway to the capitol. At one time the people voted for the moving of the capitol to where more people could become involved and it was voted to move the capitol to Anchorage area. This people's vote was disregarded by legislature as Juneau transfered property to the state for more buildings free of charge. The property is now condemned but no buildings have ever been built there. It was clearly a political payoff to keep the state house here. Yet the people are furious about any mention concerning building a roadway out of here, so that people can use something other than boats and airways to reach their capitol. No money was given to the Television station for coverage of the legislature this term. My letter was

published in the paper asking for it, but I doubt if it will do any good. How can we open state legislature to the general public? I would certainly love to have our cable TV station take a part, even if there was an extra charge.
