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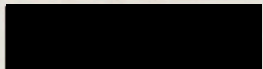

ARTICLE ONE

Section 7. *All bills for raising revenue shall originate in the House of Representatives; Section 8. The Congress shall have power to lay and collect taxes, duties, imposts and excises, to pay the debts and provide for the common defence and general welfare of the United States; but all duties, imposts and excises shall be uniform throughout the United States; To borrow money on the credit of the United States;*

ARTICLE FOUR Section 4. *The United States shall guarantee to every State in this Union a republican form of government,*

ARTICLE SIX *The Senators and Representatives..., shall be bound by oath or affirmation, to support this Constitution;*
