QUOTE, "...the Federal government is responsible for 50-75%

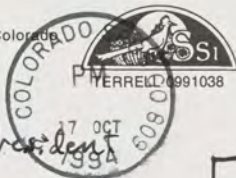
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of the cocaine that is being brought into this country.
