Dear Sir:

On April 11, 1992, I watched a program on C-SPAN, featuring John Frohnmayer (again), former chairman of the National Endowment for the Arts, as the guest speaker for the American Society of Newspaper Editors. At the conclusion the chairman said, "I'd like to thank John Frohnmayer for speaking so directly to the hearts of editors."

I was shocked that even the "hearts" of Newspaper Editors did not differentiate using tax money against Christians, from the freedom of speech. Mr. Frohnmayer and the newspaper editors support the blasphemy against our Lord Jesus Christ - the Savior of millions of Christians who paid that tax. This certainly revealed to me how Anti-Christian the media has become. How can you expect us to believe that you are fair and decent? This is blatant misuse of tax dollars to promote the anti-Christian religion of Atheism and Humanism.

You seem to ignore the fact that the first amendment was passed to prevent the government from establishing a state religion and not to hinder the freedom of religion. The first amendment was not written just for a few media people, it was written for all Americans. It came about because a group of Baptist ministers wrote to Thomas Jefferson about their fears of a Federal Religion as was true in England where they had been persecuted for preaching and for printing Bibles. Thus the freedom of the press and of speech.

When I was a young seminary student, some of the elders said that liberals were out to destroy us. I did not believe them. But you are not only hostile to Christianity, you are trying to destroy it with tax dollars. John Frohnmayer and his anti-Christian followers can have all the freedom to create all those filthy "arts" they want, but without my tax dollars! If those "artists" would create genuine art, they could support themselves without the help of tax money.

Polls reveal that media people are much more liberal than the general public. Newspaper editors evidently think it is alright to ignore millions of Christians as if they have no equal rights and that media liberals are above the rest of us. HAVE YOU GIVEN EQUAL TIME AND COURTESY TO THOSE WHOM YOU AND FROHNMAYER OFFENDED? WHY NOT?

By honoring Mr. Frohnmayer, you honor those who take our tax dollars and give it to blasphemers of Christ. That reveals your lack of respect for Christ and millions of Christians, who are the largest minority group in America. I am glad that you have never treated the Jews with such disdain, you would not dare.
