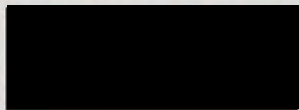

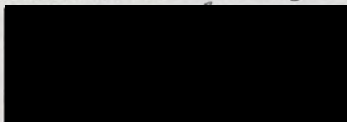
Dear Brian:

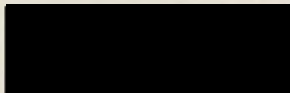
