One is a letter to the editor of the local newspaper.

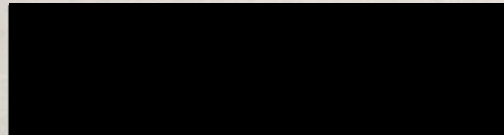
Two is a letter to the three governors with the interview with Brian Lamb.

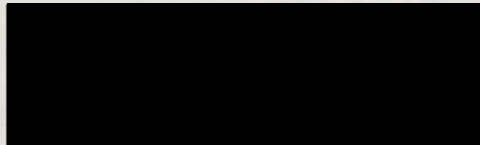
Yesterday, on C-SPAN, I watched your "Town Meeting" in Southaven, Mississippi.
