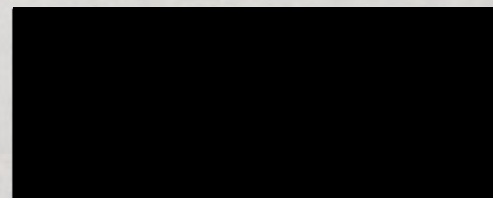

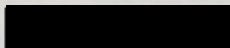
With our nation in such a state of problems, I feel it is

turmoil.

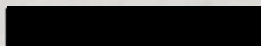
