

Black caucus targets Hamblin

A national black legislators group says it will seek a federal investigation of Denver radio station KNUS talk show host Ken Hamblin, who is black, because he engages in "minority bashing."

"Hamblin insults people of color on a daily basis. He is not serving the public interest," said Kofi Owusu, spokesman for the 400-member National Black Caucus of State Legislators, yesterday.

The caucus also intends to launch a campaign asking the show's sponsors to pressure the station "to respond appropriately to our concerns about Hamblin's insulting nature and tone," Owusu said.

Owusu said the caucus will ask the Federal Communications Commission to remove

Hamblin from the air or order him to make his remarks "more appropriate so that the station is supporting its legal obligation to serve the public's interest." Hamblin also writes a column for The Denver Post.

"I'm infuriated right now, but I keep trying to remind myself that they're losers," Hamblin said yesterday.

"If the National Black Caucus wants to take on one person in Denver, Colorado, instead of addressing the murder, the mayhem, the high prison rate, the high welfare rolls — if they think that's the solution to their problems, fine. But I'm not going to go away."

Rep. David P. Richardson Jr. of Pennsylvania called Hamblin a "race baiter" and "disgrace to black America."

C-Span

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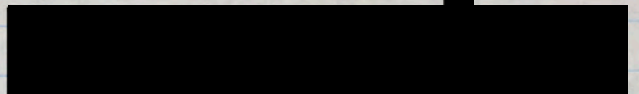
I have been watching C-span every morning because of its fair and unbiased coverage of current events.
