Jesterday I watched your show D-Day: 50 years later. It was great. I found it to be very very emotional. I m not ashamed to say that I had tears in my eyes through most of the show. The pictures of the cemeteries was heart rending. Brian on June 6, 1944

On our tank deck we had 18, 32 ton any tanks. In top dech we had ambulances, jeeps and other small rehucles.

We were supposed to land on Omoha feach in the early morning but because of congestions on the beach and sunker smaller landing croft we did not land until close to 12 PM.

I remember the water being very rough and the day oracant from the clouds and the smoke from all the gunfire after the war Brian

I'm sitting here writing this letter to you and I can still jucture the German planes stroping the feaches and our war ships bombing the German defenses. Well Buan, that's all for now.
