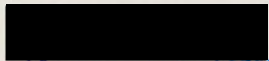

Mr. Lamb you are about to lose your super clean image. I trust that you will remedy this situation. I for one would hate to see your favorable status diminished.

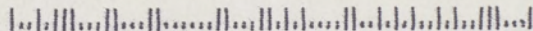
