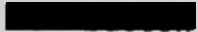

I object to using channel 34 to broadcast anything other than CSPAN.

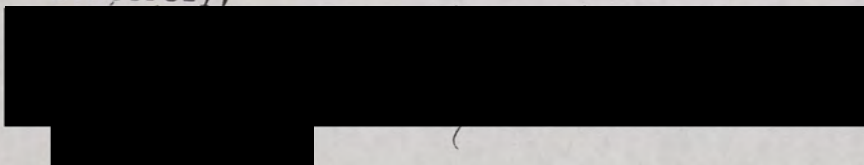
