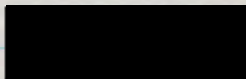

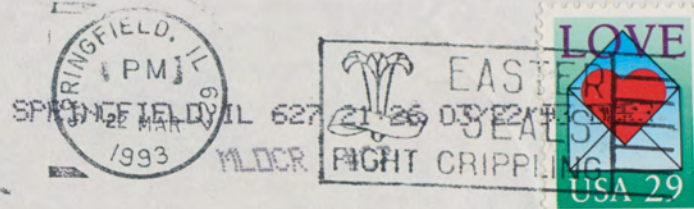
Dear Madam, or Sir - which ever,

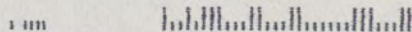
