6. Congressional shenanigans, and on and on.

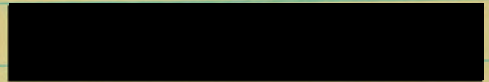
Is there one current congressional politician who can truthfully say, he or she is a real, honest public servant and that their every move
