Bible, because it all is written there.

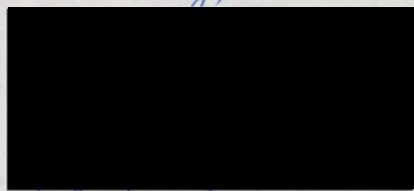
I don't know if I'm trying to actually
