Dear Mr. Lamb:

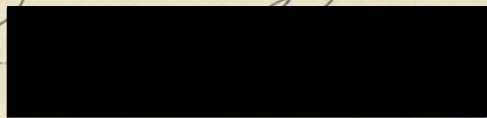

I listened to Ken Adelman ^{and} George H. W. Bush within the last three or four days ^{and} appreciated the decency with which they treated each other ^{and} the dignity

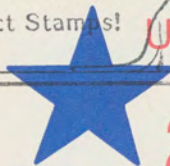
