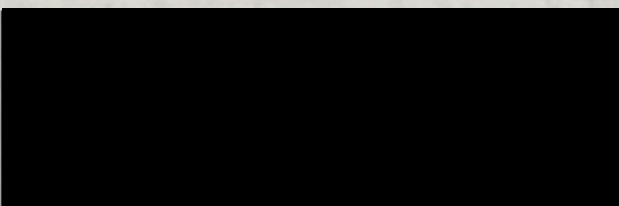

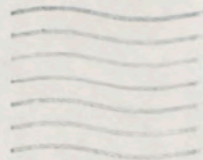
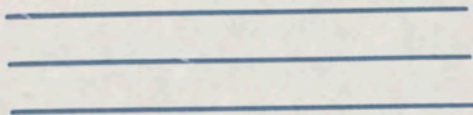
Although, I'm not so sure that this doesn't smack of bias, as if it's alright for you
