I am a regular watcher and feel sure that in the next couple weeks we will see a program or some concentration on the <u>Promise Keeper Meeting in Washington</u>, D.C. on October 4th. It is my hope that there will be some use of the truth in describing this movement.

Since I am 75 years and a woman, you can be certain that I have no axe to grind. However, I can verify that we have a large group of these members in our church and they have the complete support of their wives who say they are better husbands and fathers since joining the group.
