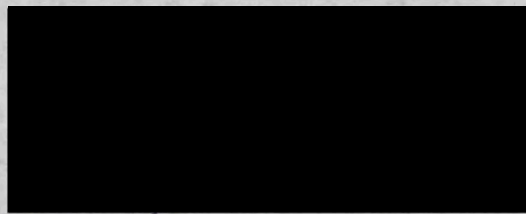
to put in the fix for the Democrats). However, when you have a liberal host and a liberal guest, but also, a conservative guest you must fix the lines so your liberal friends won't whine.
