We don't question the commentator-turned-candidate's patriotism, but we do know he didn't serve in any branch

of the military. In the '50s, Buchanan, 53, was enrolled in the Army ROTC program at Georgetown University in Washington, D.C. But in '59 he was dishonorably dismissed following a scuffle with the police during a routine traffic stop. That led to misdemeanor charges. And the young Buchanan was kicked out of school for a year over the same incident.



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
