I have several comments and criticisms. There are no listings in the weekly TV booklet inserted in most local newspapers; no listings of programming for C-Span.

I listened to the first two, Washington and the Adams during the day for a three hour period. However, when I listened to your program on Jefferson it was on a Friday night and the segment lasted for 12 hours. My question being, By watching and listening during the day for the first two segments, did I miss additional segments that were aired during your evening rerun, but not during the daytime airing?

Even though you annouced that these programs would air Monday 9:00 AM to noon and aired again Friday nights at 8:00 PM, I see both last week and in the next few weeks, you are not following this schedule. Is there any way, if one does not happen to hear your program schedule, one can learn of your schedule on events such as these?

If there were more than 3 hours on Washington and Adams aired during the evening airing, is there anyway they will be rerun still again?

Would I know of some of your programming in advance, I would surely watch. There have been times I have missed something I would have enjoyed and wanted to watch, but with no TV listing of programs, I have missed.

It would be nice if those who print the weekly TV listings would list your special programs. I realize many of your programs are based on current events and I am sure even you have no advanced warning of many programs.

I enjoyed C-Span during the Impeachment hearings, as well as your viewers comments and remarks.
