**LONG-TIME C-SPAN EMPLOYEE AND NASSAU COUNTY NATIVE  
FEATURED IN NATIONAL MAGAZINE AND AD CAMPAIGN**

Washington, D.C., May 29, 1992 -- *C-SPAN Quarterly*, the Cable Satellite Public Affairs Network's national magazine, features Field Technician Garney Gary in its Spring issue in an article entitled "Getting The Whole Picture: On the Campaign Trail." He is also part of C-SPAN's national ad campaign seen throughout the Primary season in the New York Times, The Washington Post, the Boston Globe and other papers.

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Garney Gary began his career at C-SPAN 10 years ago as a Master Control Operator. He also held the title of Field Technician before becoming a White House Camera Operator. This year marks the third presidential election Mr. Gary has covered at C-SPAN. He has traveled coast-to-coast from Kennebunkport, Maine with the President to the Republican Party Platform Committee Meetings in California; from the New Hampshire Primary to the Democratic Party Convention in Texas.

Originally from Nassau County, Mr. Gary grew up in Roosevelt, NY and attended Roosevelt Jr., Sr. High School. He obtained a degree in Communications and Broadcast Journalism from Grahm Junior College in Boston, MA and attended Suffolk University. Mr. Gary worked previously at CBS in New York and WQTV in Boston, MA before starting at C-SPAN in Washington, D.C.

## PART 2 OF 3 VETERANS' WAR GOES ON

**W**hen the Northport VA Center's plans to close a Riverhead satellite clinic three days after Memorial Day were blocked by two Long Island congressmen, VA spokeswoman Rita Sparacino remarked: "It wouldn't have been a hardship for everybody."

She pointed out that veterans who have used the two-decade-old clinic — which offers medication renewals and nursing aid — have dwindled from 30-34 patients a day to only 18, most of whom live west of the clinic. If the plans had not been halted, patients would have been referred to the closest facilities — Mount Sinai and Patchogue, 70 miles away.

On the decision to close the clinic without first informing local representatives, Sparacino called it an administrative "oversight" and said the VA had no intentions "to sneak" a closing. "We look at resources and where the needs are," said Sparacino, who added that the VA has opened and closed clinics according to the needs of local veterans before.

'Where The Needs Are ...'

In less populated areas of the country, veterans may face miles of travel to receive medical attention from Department of Veterans Affairs facilities. Those on Long Island confront a similar problem, although Nassau and Suffolk rank high in state veterans population figures.

The VA estimates that 164,000 veterans live in Nassau County. But despite being home to more veterans than even Suffolk, Nassau's veterans commute outside the county for medical care — to a Brooklyn outpatient center, a Queens extended care unit and outpatient clinic or the VA Medical Center in Northport, a half hour ride from Round Swamp Road. The trip is a hardship for some, especially aging World

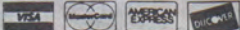
