Dear Mr. Lamb:

I would be remiss if I did not start this letter with a statement of my respect for you and C-SPAN, a precedent making service that millions of Americans find indispensable where information about government is concerned. You are truly a unique source of unvarnished information about what is going on in Washington, and I watch all the time.

However, there is one thing that you should do in my view to truly inform your viewers about the guests you have on your programs. In fact, I'll make that statement even stronger. Substitute the word MUST for should.

I refer specifically to the chart that I have enclosed-you will find that it covers many of the guests that C-SPAN invites to participate in the many and diverse programs that you provide for us. (In fairness, I must admit that you probably are not aware of the guest's involvement in these organizations when you invite them to appear). In all too many cases, the guest's membership in these organizations is not mentioned when they are introduced. I find it troubling that when these guests are confronted with questions from viewers about these organizations they simply sluff off the query with observations that they don't believe in conspiracy theories, or give some such innocuous statement that has the same effect-ridicule the very thought that there might be something to the question. All this without revealing their involvement-a clear conflict of interest that should not be permitted.

The fact is that the activities of these two PRIVATE organizations are far-reaching, and in fact are keeping the US locked into foreign and economic policies that millions of Americans do not approve of. Unfortunately, the public has little knowledge of the extent to which these two organizations have penetrated the government in Washington. It is my view that C-SPAN MUST remedy this situation, at least as regards the guests on your programs.

I recently ran across this chart, which illustrates the degree to which these outfits are involved in policy-making positions and found it striking in its implications. Of course, if you control the policies, you control the government. Now I don't know anything about the people who put the chart out, but as a freelance writer, I have made it my business to research the



activities of these two organizations for more than three years, and I can say with assurance that the chart is accurate. However, it falls far short of showing the full scope of the organizations and their activities

I also am enclosing other data which covers the memberships of each organization. I urge you to study the membership lists, both current and historical, to determine who is involved (and perhaps more importantly, those who HAVE been involved since WW II.)

If you can look at the membership of these organizations without being concerned about what is going on I'll be surprised. Look at the rest of the Annual Report and see what is going on. Look at the relationship and use of tax-free foundations in the operations of the organization. Media involvement is massive.

The result of all of this is that the controversial policies that the government adopts and follows are constantly reinforced and approved PUBLICLY by individuals in government and the media who do not reveal their connection to the organizations in question. The same thing happens on the Sunday TV talk programs that are often sponsored by companies that are headed by - SURPRISE, SURPRISE, CEO's that are also members. And often, these members hold dual membership.

Doesn't it seem strange that no one-NO ONE in government supports protectionism, the use of which created this great economy in years past? And which fuels the great economic power of Japan? One of Bush's last statements was an effort to combat the resurgence of protectionism, and to ensure his success, he linked it to isolationism. It is quite clear that the two are not related at all. Incidentally, Bush was a former Director of one of these organizations and had dual membership as well. It was he that sent our troops into Somalia- an act that cemented the idea that the US should be the enforcer for the UN. And it is clear that in creating and pushing NAFTA he was following the plans of these organizations to complete the western hemispheric part of the trilateral world

With NAFTA coming up, the full court press by these people will be stunning-and all-encompassing. Every member available will use every media outlet possible to call for its passage, all the while belittling the people who oppose passage.

For the past decade or more, poll after poll of the people have indicated that they feel that the government has been on the wrong track, a fact that polls still tell us with even greater numbers expressing that feeling. Why is it that no one ever tries to determine what is behind that feeling? Is it that free trade is the culprit- and that the people want American jobs and industries protected? I think so, but that fact is not what the government wants to hear-or have promoted. It is certainly not what these organizations want publicized.


Brian, the people need to KNOW that your guests are members of these organizations and I urge you to get your own copy of the Annual Report and membership lists. If you write and ask for them, I'm sure you will receive what you want. Look at the membership lists and compare them with the guests you have invited for the past few months. I think you'll see what I mean.

There is much more to this story-too much to relate here. It is sufficient to say that in my opinion if the full story ever comes out, the resulting scandal will be much greater than the Teapot Dome and will shake the very foundations of our government. Why did I use that comparison? Because the same kind of people are involved. Only this time, instead of oil, the real objective is control of the US government, the world's economies and establishment of a One World Government. At least that's how I see it.

Please don't take my word for all this- look into it yourself. I think you'll agree that the people need to know, because they're being misled and propagandized.

Keep up the good work! Millions are depending on you.

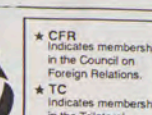
