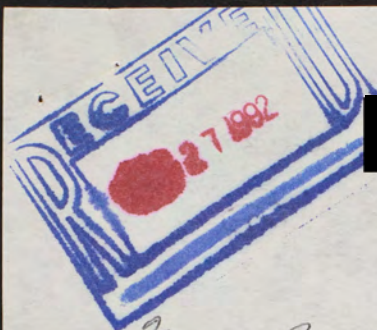

Mr Barry Miller:

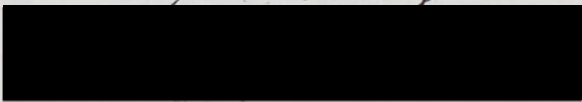
It is with the
