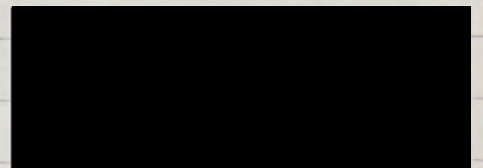

A BILL

To enhance the readiness, discipline, good order, and morale of the Armed Forces by providing by law for the continuation of the policy of the Department of Defense on homosexuals serving in the Armed Forces, as in effect on January 1, 1993

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
1 SECTION 1. CONTINUATION OF JANUARY 1, 1993, DEPART-
2 MENT OF DEFENSE POLICY CONCERNING
3 SERVICE OF HOMOSEXUALS IN THE ARMED
4 FORCES.

5 All executive orders, Department of Defense direc-
6 tives, and regulations of the military departments concern-
7 ing the appointment, enlistment, and induction, and the
8 retention, of homosexuals in the Armed Forces of the
9 United States, as in effect on January 1, 1993, shall re-
10 main in effect with respect to the Army, Navy, Air Force,
11 and Marine Corps unless changed by law.

EMERGENCY MILITARY ORDER TO PRESIDENT CLINTON

Dear President Clinton,

WHEREAS, all military experts, regardless of political party, agree homosexuals must not be forced on our Armed Forces,

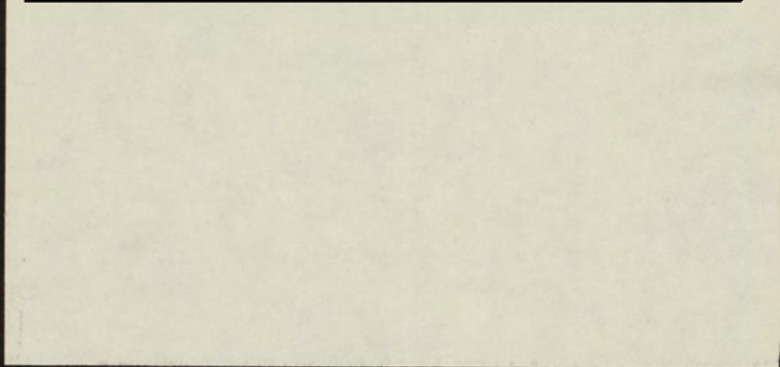
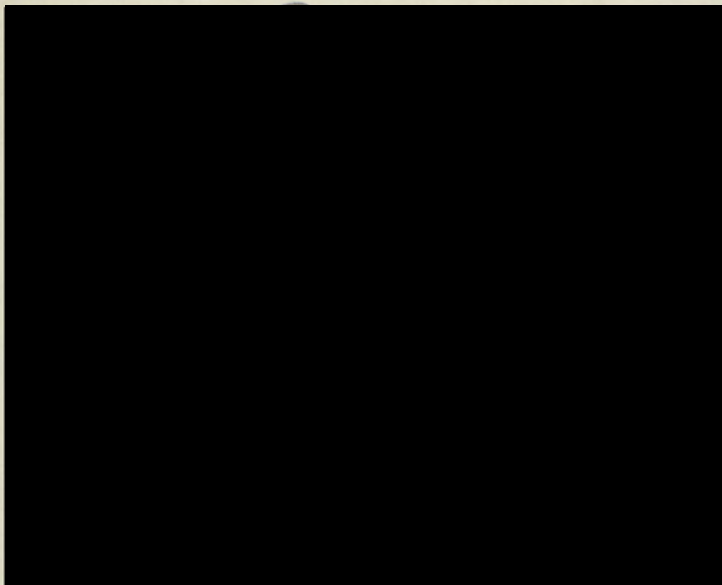
