Dear C-Span:

On behalf of the tens of thousands of Russians living in San Diego and Los Angeles California we thank you for broadcasting the Russian News from Moscow. Also living in San Francisco.

Many non-Russian programs are broadcast in the bilingual mode, particularly in Spanish, and we would like to know if it is possible for C-Span to transmit the Russian Evening News in the original Russian language? Or, on one speaker in stereo?

A few months ago I believe you had a less competent translator but it was okay because his voice overlay followed rather than drowned out the Russian commentators. It was possible to get almost the entire news in Russian. This is no longer the case and perhaps half the Russians living in the United States are not versed in English and need the news translated back into Russian. Is there any hope for these emigres?

Any help in bilingual broadcasting would be of enormous benefit in helping recent Russian emigres to adjust to this country.
