Do you believe that the Congress can really create jobs in the private sector of this country without costing the taxpayer money? If so, how? 5. Do you believe the War Powers Act to be in line with our constitution? 6. Would you vote for a Constitutional Amendment that would make the popular vote of the people the determining factor in electing our President and Vice-president? If not, why? &. Are you in favor of enacting a flat rate of taxes for both individual citizens and business? 7. Should the terms of U.S. Representatives be increased to a four year term? If so, would you limit the terms? 8. Do you believe that all type of weapons owned by U.S. citizens should be registered with the Federal Government? 1

9. Do you believe that an independent agency should be enacted by the Congress that would receive FICA taxes and make disbursement of benefits to Americans? If not, why?
