I have always held the greatest respect for C-span, but that respect waned with one of your recent actions. Either purposely-- or unpurposely-- you have just slapped the Illinois Black Community in the face. Why did you exclude the only African-American-- and the only woman-- gubernatorial candidate from your Illinois Campaign special (8/26/90)? She has been on record with the State Board of Elections, as the Illinois Solidarity Party's Candidate, for months. Why has the Black Community been ignored? I've contacted the FCC, and they said that networks are bound to provide equal coverage of established party's candidates (the ISP is an established party!). There have already been calls made to Black radio stations, asking the same questions, that I'm asking now.
