Dear Mr Lamb,

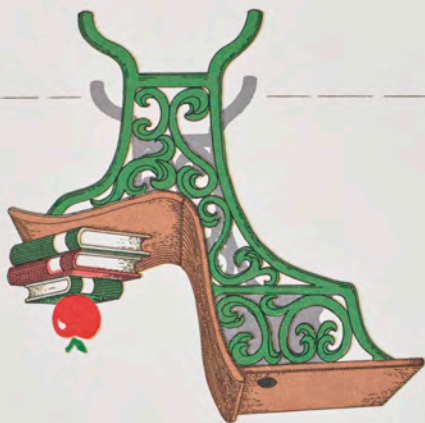
