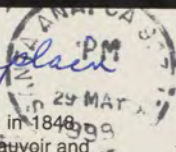


Beauvoir

A Louisiana-style raised cottage built in 1848, 1851 by wealthy planter James Brown, Beauvoir and its surrounding grounds was purchased in 1879 by former Confederate President Jefferson Davis as his retirement estate. Fronting the Gulf of Mexico, the national historic landmark home is the focal point of a 52-acre museum complex honoring Davis and the Confederacy.
