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Dear Sir :

I write to you and your station C-SPAN/C-SPAN-2 because I am frustrated with the House of Representatives and Senate . I commend you and your Staff for bring this and other information to the American people not available elsewhere. What I write may sound dumb and would never take effect, but think about it.

I listen to the speeches by both sides of the Isle. After hours, days or longer I believe neither side has listened to the other [there is a *mind set* ! few if any, either party, will change a mind]. Then the question is called. What happens?
