Again, thank you and your competent staff for one of the best programs I've seen on TV in a long time. Keep up your outstanding job. I watch C-Span more than any other channel.

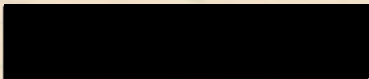

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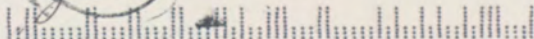
