C-SPAN LOOKS AT "A DAY IN THE LIFE" OF BRITISH POLITICIAN

Washington, D.C., January 11 -- C-SPAN will air a two-hour look at a day in the life of British Member of Parliament Emma Nicholson on **Sunday, January 14, at 1:00pm ET.**

Ms. Nicholson, a Conservative member of Parliament for 10 years, recently led a C-SPAN camera crew around during a typical work day. She travelled through her constituency, visiting local businesses and meeting with citizens, as well as playing the piano at a late-night telethon to benefit needy children.

C-SPAN began airing the British House of Commons in November.
