9:00 am ET. Florida Sen. Robert Graham moderates the panel, featuring South Carolina

Rep. Liz Patterson and Texas State Sen. Chet Edwards. C-SPAN opens its phone lines

for viewer comments at 10:15 am ET when the session adjourns, as well as during

other panel intermissions. The next session, "The Super Tuesday Opportunity:

Building a New Democratic Coalition," is chaired by Georgia Sen. Wyche Fowler and

begins at 10:30 am ET.

At noon ET, C-SPAN breaks away from coverage of the DLC meeting in order to fulfill a commitment to live coverage of the U.S. House of Representatives, but will resume the live DLC telecast when the House concludes its legislative business. Programs from the DLC's afternoon agenda that are pre-empted by House coverage will air tape-delayed on Saturday, June 27th at 10:30 pm ET. Panels subject to pre-emption include: "A Town Meeting with Democratic Candidates for President," featuring Rev. Jesse Jackson and Sens.
