-- C-SPAN'S STATES OF THE NATION '85 VISITS INDIANA'S "CINDERELLA CITY" --

-- Cable Network Covers Indiana Politics/Great Lakes Cable Show --

WASHINGTON, D.C.-- "C-SPAN intends to explore the political soul of Indiana for cable viewers on our 'States of the Nation '85' visit to Indianapolis this month," says the network's producer Carl Rutan.

Indiana has a nationwide reputation for excellence in sports -- auto racing, fast-break basketball and, most recently, pro football -- but what of its political renown? September 25 - 27, C-SPAN plans to take a comprehensive look at Indiana government from the vantage point of its capital city, recently called "the Cinderella of the rustbelt" by Newsweek magazine.

The network's three-day coverage includes live viewer call-ins with Indiana Gov. Robert Orr, Lt. Gov. John Mutz, Indianapolis Mayor William Hudnut and Rep. Andy Jacobs. Also featured are the presidents of Purdue and Indiana Universities and various editors from the Indianapolis Star and News. Roundtable discussions with Indianapolis business leaders and city-county council members will be cablecast during C-SPAN's visit as well.

Indianapolis is the home of The Saturday Evening Post and while in the city, C-SPAN cameras will focus on this, one of the nation's oldest magazines. This special program includes a call-in with Post owner Beurt SerVaas, a taped interview with the current cover artist, and a look back at Norman Rockwell's works which once graced Saturday Evening Post covers, typifying Americana.

Another aspect of C-SPAN's Indiana programming is coverage of the Great Lakes Cable Show. C-SPAN will televise speeches from the cable show, including an address by Sen. Richard Lugar to the conventioners, live via satellite from C-SPAN's Washington studios.

Cable viewers can also catch glimpses of Indianapolis and the surrounding area -- C-SPAN 'video verite' style -- as America's Network continues its travels through America's heartland.
