I am writing to let you know that I am disappointed that CSPAN did not carry coverage today of Mr. Ross Perot's testimony before the Senate Banking Committee on NAFTA. It is my understanding that it is the obligation of CSPAN to provide coverage of congressional activity. While the dedication of the Holocaust Museum is an important event, it does not supersede the importance of the testimony and discussions on NAFTA. This trade agreement will have a far-reaching effect on our economy and job base far into the next century. We must have the opportunity to view this congressional activity.
