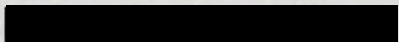
If a program like this is ever developed, and advertised, it would be one of the largest viewer draws C-Span has had in a long time, and that would be difficult to accomplish. Thank You.

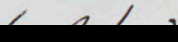
Wouldn't it be wonderful to have all our students make learning their paramount concern while in school, as opposed to drugs, weapons, and other activities that impedes the learning processes?

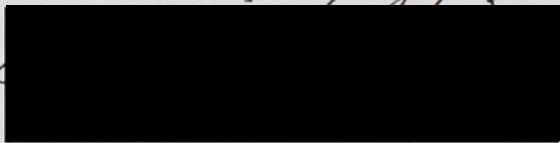
