PRESIDENT BUSH TO ADDRESS NATION'S GOVERNORS  
JULY 31 AT ANNUAL MEETING IN CHICAGO

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- The National Governors' Association today announced that President George Bush will address the governors on July 31, during the association's 81st annual meeting in Chicago.

"The Governors are delighted that President Bush can join us in Chicago," NGA Chairman Gerald L. Baliles, Virginia, said. "Our ongoing dialogue with the President is essential, particularly in light of the growing role of states in the international economy."

NGA Vice Chairman Terry E. Branstad of Iowa said, "President Bush honored us by making his first official appearance at the NGA meeting last fall. Since then, the nation's governors have developed an important working relationship with the president, especially in international trade, education, and the environment."

Illinois Governor James R. Thompson, host for the annual meeting, said "We are extremely pleased to welcome President Bush to Chicago. His comments to Governors on the heels of his ten-day trip to Europe, which included the economic summit, will be especially timely as we explore the issue of international trade."

This will be the president's fourth meeting with the Governors since his election. As President-elect, his first official event was a November 18 meeting with the NGA Executive Committee and new governors in Charlottesville, Va. On May 16, the President met with the NGA Executive Committee at the White House, and on May 22 he hosted a state dinner for governors.

The annual meeting will focus on "America in Transition: The International Frontier," NGA's initiative headed by Gov. Baliles to improve U.S. performance in the international marketplace.

CABINET SECRETARIES, ANCHORMAN, ASTRONOMER, FORMER AMBASSADOR  
TO JOIN NATION'S GOVERNORS IN CHICAGO JULY 30 - AUGUST 1

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- U.S. Commerce Secretary Robert Mosbacher, U.S. Transportation Secretary Samuel K. Skinner, CBS News Anchorman Dan Rather, former U.S. Ambassador to the United Nations Andrew Young, and astronomer/author Carl Sagan will join the nation's governors in Chicago July 30-August 1 for the annual meeting of the National Governors' Association.

The nation's governors meet twice a year to focus their collective attention on issues central to states -- and to develop policy on critical domestic and international issues. This year's meeting will be hosted by Illinois Governor James R. Thompson.

The annual meeting will focus on "America in Transition: The International Frontier," NGA's ongoing effort to improve U.S. performance in the international economy. Under the leadership of NGA Chairman Gerald L. Baliles of Virginia, the initiative is charting the steps Governors can take to increase American competitiveness in the next century.

Governors and their guests will hear from the "America in Transition" task forces, which "examined issues that form the foundation for the nation's future: foreign markets, international education, transportation infrastructure, research and technology, domestic markets, and children," Gov. Baliles said.

Major speakers during the two-day meeting include:

- U.S. Commerce Secretary Robert Mosbacher will discuss new overseas markets for American products.
- U.S. Transportation Secretary Samuel K. Skinner will discuss transportation infrastructure at the second plenary session.
- ~~Dan Rather~~, anchorman for CBS Evening News, will discuss the role of the media outside U.S. borders at the closing plenary session.
- ~~Dr. Carl Sagan~~ of Cornell University, an astronomer, author, and educator, will discuss global climate change and its implications for government policy.
- Atlanta Mayor Andrew Young, a former ambassador to the United Nations, will discuss international trade and development.
- ~~U.S. Sen. Bill Bradley~~ of New Jersey will discuss challenges for American leadership in the global economy of the 1990s during the opening plenary session.
- ~~Former U.S. Sen. Charles Percy of Illinois~~ will discuss plans to construct an international trade and cultural center in Washington, D.C., to house federal agencies, embassies' visa operations, and other offices with international missions. Percy is chairman of the U.S. International Cultural and Trade Center Commission.
- Federal Reserve Board Chairman Alan Greenspan will discuss the states' evolving role in the new global economy.
- House Surface Transportation Subcommittee Chairman Norman Y. Mineta of California will discuss congressional plans to reauthorize federal highway and mass transit programs as the Interstate highway system comes to completion.
- Ira C. Magaziner, author of The Silent War: Inside the Global Business Battles Shaping America's Future, will discuss U.S. competitiveness in the international arena.

Other issues on the annual meeting agenda include 1990 farm legislation, prison crowding, drug enforcement in urban settings and national drug control policy, community service, immigration, tax-exempt financing, and education.

Prison Crowding, Fighting Drug Abuse. The Justice and Public Safety Committee will hear from Judge William W. Wilkins Jr., chairman of the U.S. Sentencing Commission. Wilkins will discuss how sentencing guidelines can alleviate prison crowding. Robert Watson, Delaware's corrections department

commissioner, and Orville Pung, Minnesota's corrections department commissioner, will discuss alternative punishments used by states to reduce prison crowding.

Florida Gov. Bob Martinez, NGA's lead governor on substance abuse and drug trafficking, will discuss state drug-fighting initiatives and the role that foreign aid, international treaties, and hemispheric organizations can play in a national drug policy. Focusing on supply and demand, the governor will present a video of his recent trip to cocaine-producing regions of South America. Gov. Martinez traveled to Bolivia and Colombia to explore remote cultivation areas and met with officials of both countries and representatives of U.S. embassies, the Drug Enforcement Agency, and the military.

Charleston, S.C. Police Chief Reuben Greenberg will discuss drug enforcement in urban settings. Judge Reggie B. Walton, associate director of the federal Office of National Drug Control Policy, will update the governors on the office's efforts.

Human Resource Issues. NGA's Human Resources Committee will hear a panel presentation on community service, including Robert Burkhardt, director of the San Francisco Conservation Corps; Harry Silcos, principal of Lincoln High School in Philadelphia; and Treva Knasel, a participant in Ohio's Civilian Conservation Corps. The panel's moderator is Cindy Cecil Lazarus, a member of the Columbus, Ohio, city council.

The committee will also hear from Robert Blendon of Harvard University's School of Public Health, who will present an overview of the U.S. health care system. Minnesota Gov. Rudy Perpich, NGA education subcommittee chairman, will present the subcommittee's report and will chair a special session on education.

Public Finance, Liability Insurance. The Economic Development and Technological Innovation Committee will hear a report on the Anthony Commission on Tax Exempt Financing, a group of federal, state, and local public officials and private-sector representatives concerned about the future of public finance. Arkansas Gov. Bill Clinton and South Carolina Gov. Carroll A. Campbell Jr. are members of the commission.

In addition, Peter W. Huber, author of Liability: The Legal Revolution and its Consequences, will discuss liability insurance. Huber is a senior fellow at the Manhattan Institute.

Telecommunications, Transportation. The Committee on Transportation, Commerce, and Communications will hear from two corporate chief executive officers, William G. McGowan of MCI Communications Corp. and William L. Weiss of Ameritech, who will discuss the economic promise of telecommunications. The committee also examine transportation for the future.

Environment. NGA's Energy and Environment Committee will hear Dr. Carl Sagan of Cornell University discuss global climate change.

Agriculture. The governors will discuss state issues in proposed 1990 farm legislation -- including General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade (GATT) negotiations, drought, environmental concerns, and rural development -- during the Agriculture and Rural Development Committee session.

International Trade. U.S. Commerce Secretary Mosbacher and former Sen. Percy will present their remarks to the International Trade and Foreign Relations Committee.
