C-SPAN TELEVISES CONSERVATIVE POLITICAL ACTION CONFERENCE

-- Conservative Groups Address Public Policy Issues --

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- C-SPAN cable network plans live coverage of the 14th annual Conservative Political Action Conference (C-PAC), held in Washington, D.C., February 19-21. Headlining the C-PAC conference agenda is an address by President Ronald Reagan, seen live on C-SPAN at 8:00 pm EST, Thursday, February 19.

On Saturday, February 21, C-SPAN televises, live, the morning session of the conference, featuring speeches on U.S. defense policy and America's future by administration officials and public policymakers. C-SPAN's telecast includes the remarks of Assistant Secretary of Defense Richard Perle, former Secretary of State Alexander Haig, Phyllis Schlafly, and former Delaware Governor and '88 Presidential contender Pierre DuPont.

The C-PAC conference is co-sponsored by the American Conservative Union and Young Americans for Freedom. Over fifty special interest groups from across the conservative spectrum are expected to attend the conference to discuss issues of current concern and to analyze the conservative movement in the United States.
